Identification and IDs

Please ensure you have a valid driver's license or passport with you when attending meetings on Capitol Hill or in Administration Buildings. The Capitol Hill Police have relaxed their security protocols significantly in the past 6-8 months, however, with the recent attacks in the Middle East and the related protests, that have stepped up security just a bit and they have required spot ID checks in the last month.


Attire for Meetings

Wednesday and Thursday's meetings will be business attire.


Health Safety / Masking Protocols in DC
