-  1 to 2 Hour Timed Parking: Residential areas. Park for free once per day
-  PayByPhone Parking Only: No cash options available

## Parking Lots



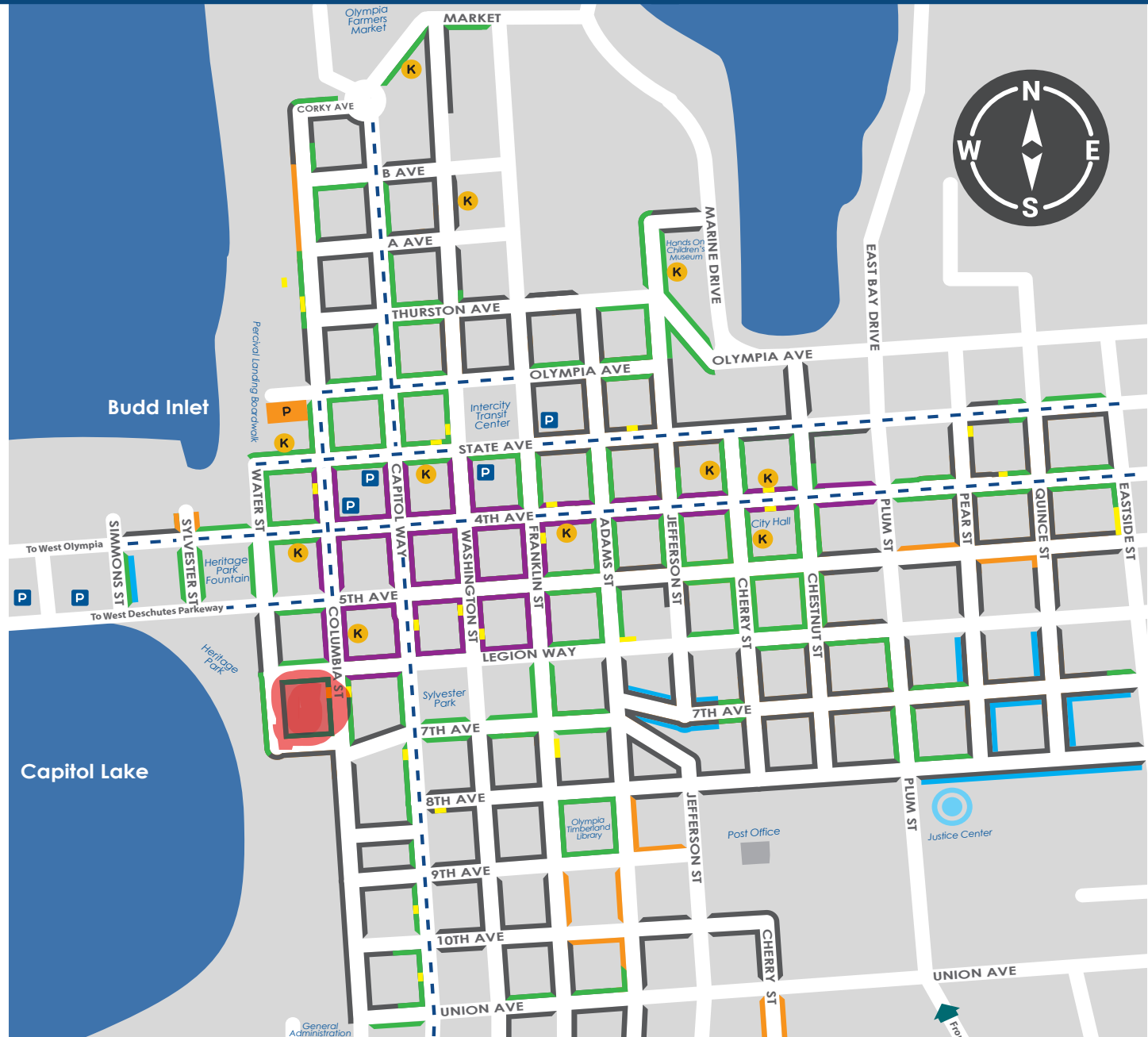
### City of Olympia Parking Lots:

- Curbside Pickup: 15 minute pick-up and drop-off sites to get in/out fast
- On-street paid parking for convenient access to popular Downtown spaces
- PayByPhone app for maximum flexibility
- Monthly permits for cost-effective resident and employee access to city leased parking lots
- Fifteen Fare-Free Intercity Transit bus routes to move thousands of people in and out of downtown daily
- Annual Residential Parking permits
- Walkable downtown lifestyles supported by resident parking permits
- Free parking lot options when demand drops on weeknights and weekends

## PayByPhone

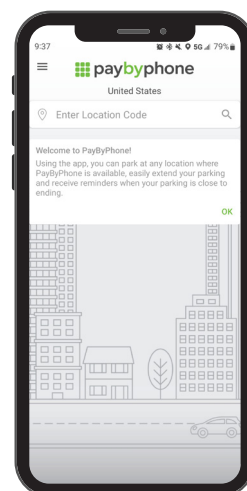
PayByPhone is a service where customers can choose to pay for parking using an app on their smartphone. Running late and need more time on your meter? No worries! You can add time remotely as long as you do not exceed the time limit of the meter. You can also receive notifications when your meter is about to expire so you never forget to pay.

It's easy just download the app or visit the PayByPhone website, register, enter your license plate number and pay!

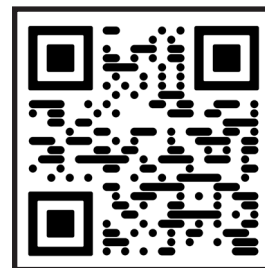


## New Parking Kiosks

If you regularly use cash or credit rather than your phone to park at downtown meters, you may need to use one of 11 new kiosks to pay for on-street parking in some parts of downtown Olympia.

Kiosks will serve on-street and lot customers with cash and credit transactions. At these locations, customers have the benefit of being able to request a printed receipt. Remember to keep your license plate number handy.

## Parking Lots

City leased parking lots allow users to park anytime for one flat fee per month. Permits can be purchased monthly online at the City of Olympia parking portal or at Olympia City Hall, 601 4th Ave E. The SL, PB and AL lots also allow hourly-based parking through a kiosk or the PayByPhone app. Free parking in all City lots is available on evenings and weekends.
