Identification and IDs

Please ensure you have a valid driver’s license or passport with you as we go to Capitol Hill, NCUA, CFPB, and the Federal Reserve, as you will need identification to gain entrance to certain buildings. Capitol Hill has relaxed their security protocols significantly in the past few months, but other buildings still may require valid ID for access.

Transportation in and around Washington, DC

Most transportation can be accomplished by using the Metro, Uber, Lift, or traditional taxis. There is really no need to rent a vehicle unless you have a personal reason to venture outside the beltway. Additionally, parking can be challenging and expensive in the D.C. metro area.

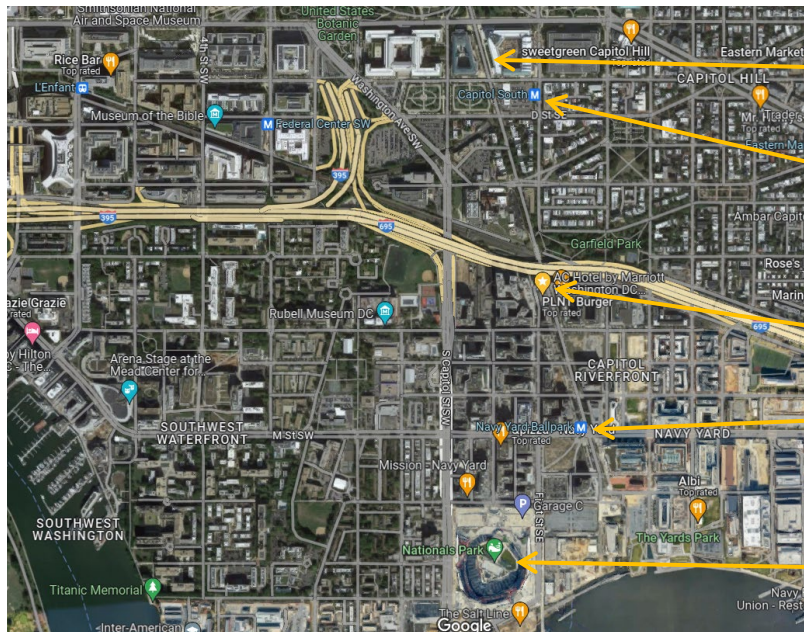
Attire for Meetings
