## **Identification and IDs**

Please ensure you have a valid driver's license or passport with you as we go to Capitol Hill, NCUA, CFPB, and the Federal Reserve, as you will need identification to gain entrance to certain buildings. Capitol Hill has relaxed their security protocols significantly in the past few months, but other buildings still may require valid ID for access.


## **Attire for Meetings**

Wednesday and Thursday's meetings will be business attire.


## **Health Safety / Masking Protocols in DC**
